

THE COUNTRY CLUB OF JOHNSTON COUNTY

Golf Play

- 1) *All golfers must register in the Golf Shop before teeing off and all play must begin at the #1 tee, unless otherwise approved by the Golf Shop Staff. No players may cut in front of groups making the turn.*
- 2) *Only groups of three or four will be permitted to play between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on weekends and holidays unless otherwise approved by the Golf Staff. The same applies to Wednesday between 12:00 noon and 2:00 p.m. Approved groups of 5 must keep pace with groups ahead. Groups of more than 5 are prohibited.*
- 3) *Players are not permitted to have more than one ball in play and practice on the course is prohibited.*
- 4) *Players are required to repair divots on fairways, ball marks on greens, and rake sand traps.*
- 5) *All players must be appropriately attired at all times. Men are not permitted to wear tank tops. Collared shirts are required! Golf appropriate shoes are required. No bare feet, flip flops, or sandals allowed.*
- 6) *The desired length of time for a round of golf at CCJC is 4 hours or less.*
- 7) *Allow faster groups to play through.*
- 8) *Use litter baskets and trash containers.*
- 9) *Dogs not permitted on Country Club grounds.*
- 10) *Parking is permitted in designated areas only. Do not block access to practice putting green.*
- 11) *No metal spikes are allowed on course.*
- 12) *No biking or skating allowed on course.*

Guests

- 1) *Persons residing within Johnston County may be guests of any member for golfing privileges once per quarter. Persons residing outside of Johnston County may be a guest of any member for golfing privileges as often as invited.*
- 2) *The club member must arrange for and sponsor a guest before he/she will be permitted to play.*
- 3) *Members who host a guest, either accompanied or unaccompanied, are responsible to see that each guest abides by the rules and regulations and the hosting member will be responsible for any charges the guest may incur.*

Miscellaneous

- 1) *The driving range is open on any day that the golf course is open. Opening and closing of the driving range is at the discretion of the Head Golf Professional or the Greens Superintendent.*
- 2) *Range balls will not be given out after the Golf Shop closes.*
- 3) *Do not park golf carts on Driving Range Tee Area.*
- 4) *Hit range balls toward center of range only.*
- 5) *Junior golfers are defined as golfers age 17 and under.*

Golf Fees

Green Fees: *\$20.00 During the week*
 \$30.00 During the weekend.

Cart Rental: *\$15.00 + tax per person 18 holes.*

Refunds/Rain Checks:

- No charge if you've played less than 4 holes.*
- No refunds for groups that have played more than 12 holes.*

Carts

- 1) You must have a valid driver's license to rent a golf cart or to operate a member owned cart.*
- 2) Persons without a license must be with an adult to operate any golf cart.*
- 3) Follow the 90E cart rule and cart direction signs.*
- 4) Stay out of wet areas.*
- 5) Carts must return to cart paths at green posts. Carts must stay on path at tee boxes and on Par 3's.*
- 6) Insurance regulations prohibit more than two occupants per golf cart.*
- 7) Members will be responsible for any and all damages to their assigned golf cart or their guest's assigned golf cart.*
- 8) No more than three carts are allowed in a group.*
