Golf Play for Members and Guests

March 1, 2010

Golf is open to Guests on Monday through Friday unlimited, and Saturday and Sunday after 10:30am. Members have 8:00am to 10:30am on Saturday and Sunday reserved for play (weather or other circumstances may dictate that these times be changed to allow better access for Members).

Members may call for a tee time if they wish 14 days out. Guests may call for a tee time no earlier than 7 days out.

All players must be appropriately attired at all times. Men must wear a collared shirt. Golf shoes and sneakers are allowed, but no sandals or flip-flops, etc.

All golfers must register in the Golf Shop before teeing off, and all play must begin at the #1 tee unless otherwise approved by the Golf Shop Staff. No players may cut in front of groups making the turn.

The desired length of time for a round of golf at CCJC is 4 hours or less. Please allow faster groups to play through.

Groups of more than four must be approved by the Golf Shop. Groups of more than five are prohibited. No more than three carts are allowed in a group.

Insurance regulations require that the driver of the golf cart must have a valid driver's license to operate a rented golf cart or a Member owned cart. Insurance regulations prohibit more than two occupants per golf cart, also.

Players are required to honor the 90 degree rule during normal play and cart path only when applicable. Please stay out of wet areas at all times.

Carts must remain on the path when teeing off and on par 3's.

All alcoholic beverages must be purchased from CCJC. No personal coolers.

Metal spikes are not allowed.

Players are not permitted to have more than one ball in play, and practice on the course is prohibited.

Players are required to repair divots on the fairways, ball marks on the greens, and rake the sand traps.

Members or guests will be responsible for any/all damages to their assigned golf cart.

Use litter baskets and trash containers.

Dogs or other pets are not permitted on the grounds.

Parking is permitted in designated areas only.

No biking or any other non-golf activity allowed on the course.

Profanity is not allowed on the golf course. Please be conscience of those around you.

Please respect those around you. We want everyone to feel welcome at the course so they'll come back.

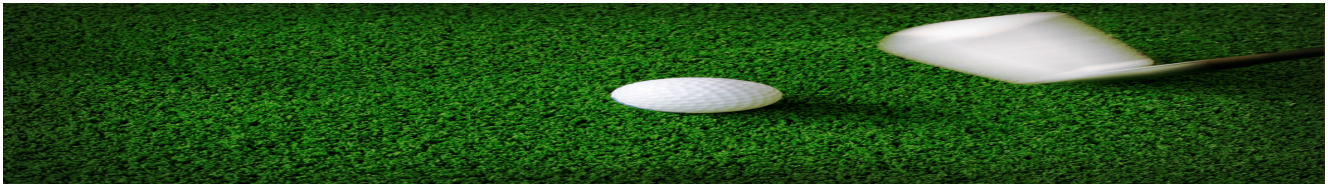
Wednesday Night Super ball beginning March 24.
