

RULES REMINDER

5.03 Any member who fails to pay their dues, authorized assessments or accounts due the Club by the end of the month those dues, assessments or charges were levied will be considered delinquent and be charged a late fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00). When a member becomes delinquent, their name and amount past due shall be posted on the Club's bulletin boards and a letter shall be sent to the member immediately by the Club Treasurer advising them that such an action has been taken. Any member still in default in the payment of their account past the second month their dues, assessments, or accounts were originally due, shall be suspended from all Club activities. If a member remains past due into the third month will be mailed a letter stating that the balance of their account must be paid within fifteen (15) days or legal action will be taken and additional charges for court costs will be added to their account. For a member to be reinstated their account must be brought current and they must submit a letter to the Board of Directors requesting reinstatement. Any member who is a month delinquent three (3) times within any twelve (12) month period shall be fined one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and/or will be deemed financially irresponsible and thus subject to suspension or expulsion.

Thanks to all Members for their faithful payments of their dues and other charges. It is imperative that we receive these payments as scheduled in order to operate the Club.

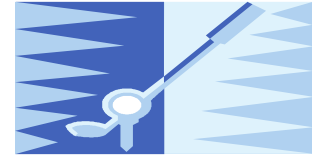

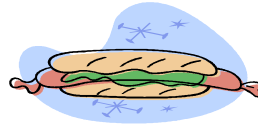
